
2024 FORSYTH-MONROE COUNTY SPORTS HALL OF FAME BILL LYONS



Bill Lyons was a Hubbard High School basketball and football star from 1962-65. Lyons had an award-winning high school basketball career for the Tigers, averaging 22 points per game on the hardwood.
