FORSYTH-MONROE COUNTY SPORTS HALL OF FAME

KEKE CALLOWAY



Keondria “Keke” Calloway was a basketball star at Mary Persons High School from 2012-15 as the Lady Dogs compiled a remarkable 99-14 record during her four-year career, including three consecutive Region 2-AAAA championships from 2012-14. Calloway also led the Lady Dogs to their first Final Four appearance in 37 years in 2013 with a 27-point masterpiece in a home quarterfinal win over Woodland (Henry). Calloway, the two-time Macon Telegraph Middle Georgia Player of the Year and two-time Region 2-AAAA Player of the Year, is MP’s second all-time leading scorer with 2,115 career points, including 694 during her senior season in 2014-15. Calloway then moved on to Mercer University, where she scored 1,811 points in her college career while leading the Lady Bears to a 104-27 record during her outstanding four-year stint from 2016-19. Calloway’s Lady Bears’ squads won back-to-back Southern Conference tournaments in 2018 and 2019 earning back-to-back NCAA Tournament berths in the process. Calloway was named 1st Team All-Southern Conference in 2018 and 2019 while setting new school records for three-pointers made in a career (298), three-pointers made in a single season (99) and three-pointers made in a single game (12). After finishing her Mercer career, Calloway has gone on to play professionally in Poland and Finland.
